

Titular organist, Dr.phil. Alexander Koschel

Comprehensive music studies as well as participation in and as a teacher at several Masterclasses have been the foundation for his extensive recital appearances and several CD-recordings and musicological publications.

He was appointed Titular Organist of the Schloßkirche St Trinitatis in Weißenfels in 1998.

As performer and musicologist he has devoted himself in particular to the music of Central Germany of the period up to the times of J S Bach and of the German Romantic Movement, in which fields he enjoys international acclaim as an outstanding musician.

In addition to this, he has been committed as founder and, since 1999, President of the "Ladegast Society" to the preservation of the legacy of Friedrich Ladegast as well as to the world of the Central German organ.
